What happens after school

Right after school - your grace period

Once you're done with school, or if you drop below half-time status as a student, your loans enter a period known as the grace period. During this time, you'll have six months until you need to make your first student loan payment.

After your grace period is over, you'll continue receiving information from us including your monthly student loan billing statement about three weeks before your payment is due. At that time, log in to your online account to explore our repayment plans - we have many different options that will make it easy for your payment to fit within your budget.

Log in to your account

You're several months into your six-month student loan grace period (which started after you graduated or dropped below half-time status at your school). We want you to succeed! Please let us know if you have questions about your loans, or if you need to explore repayment plans that will work better for

Here's What You Need to Do

- . Log in to Nelnet.com to find all of the details for your student loans serviced by Nelnet.
- . Check nslds.ed.gov to see student loans you have with Nelnet and other loan servicers; if you need a new access PIN, request one at pin.ed.gov
- . Update all of your contact information when you log in to Nelnet.com so you'll never miss important information about your account.
- . Enroll in eStatements to save paper and stay organized, we'll store them online and email you when a new statement is ready.
- . Consider making automatic monthly payments with our KwikPay® service to ensure you're paying on time.
- . Don't miss a payment. Sign up to receive text messages when your payment is due.
- . Download the Loan Assist app, for iPhone and Android, to manage your account on the go.

Important Information from Nelnet

- . The payment schedule for your student loans with Nelnet will be in the left navigation under Payment Schedule when you log in to
- . You'll receive monthly statements (via mail or email based on your selected preference at Nelnet.com) specifying your payment due date and amount about three weeks before the due date

Which Repayment Plan is Best for You?

Paying off a student loan is a big responsibility. We're here to help you fit your payments within your budget so you won't have to worry about getting behind on your student loans.

Many types of repayment plans are available, which means you can find the one that best fits your needs. If you're unsure which plan would fit your budget, use our loan repayment calculators

Types of Repayment Plans

To explore these options or to pick a new repayment plan, log in to Nelnet.com and click Lower My Payments.

Standard Repayment

The most common and economical repayment plan is Standard Repayment this will be your plan unless you choose a different repayment option. This plan spreads equal payments over 10 years.

Graduated Repayment

Payments start low and gradually increase over the years, making this a potentially wise choice for young professionals who expect to earn more money as they advance in their careers.

Extended Repayment

For borrowers who have more than \$30,000 in certain federal student loans the Extended Repayment Plan makes monthly payments more affordable, but it will take a longer amount of time to pay off the loan (up to 25 years).

Repayment Plans Based on Your Income

We have several repayment plans available that adjust and determine your monthly payment based on your income and family size.

 - Regularly scheduled statements, reminders, and text alerts












- Loan Assist App
 - iPhone and Android
 - Make payments
 - Allows borrowers to schedule payments up to 30 days in advance
 - Can review account and group summary
 - View their payment history
 - Check status of deferment/forbearance requests
 - Use loan calculators
 - Sign up for text alerts





- Loan Calculator App
 - iPhone and Android
 - Calculate monthly payments
 - Explore the amount of interest that will accrue during a period of deferment or forbearance
 - View different repayment scenarios





- Text messaging
 - Borrowers can opt in
 - Payment due date
 - Past due notifications
 - Loan status changes
 - Notifications that their online statement is ready to view






